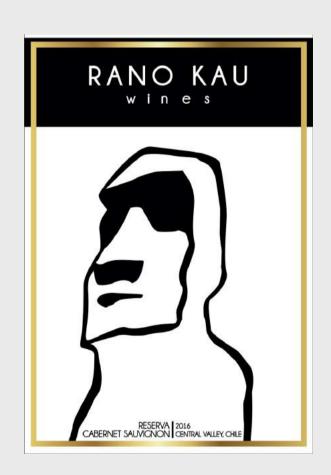


WINE
